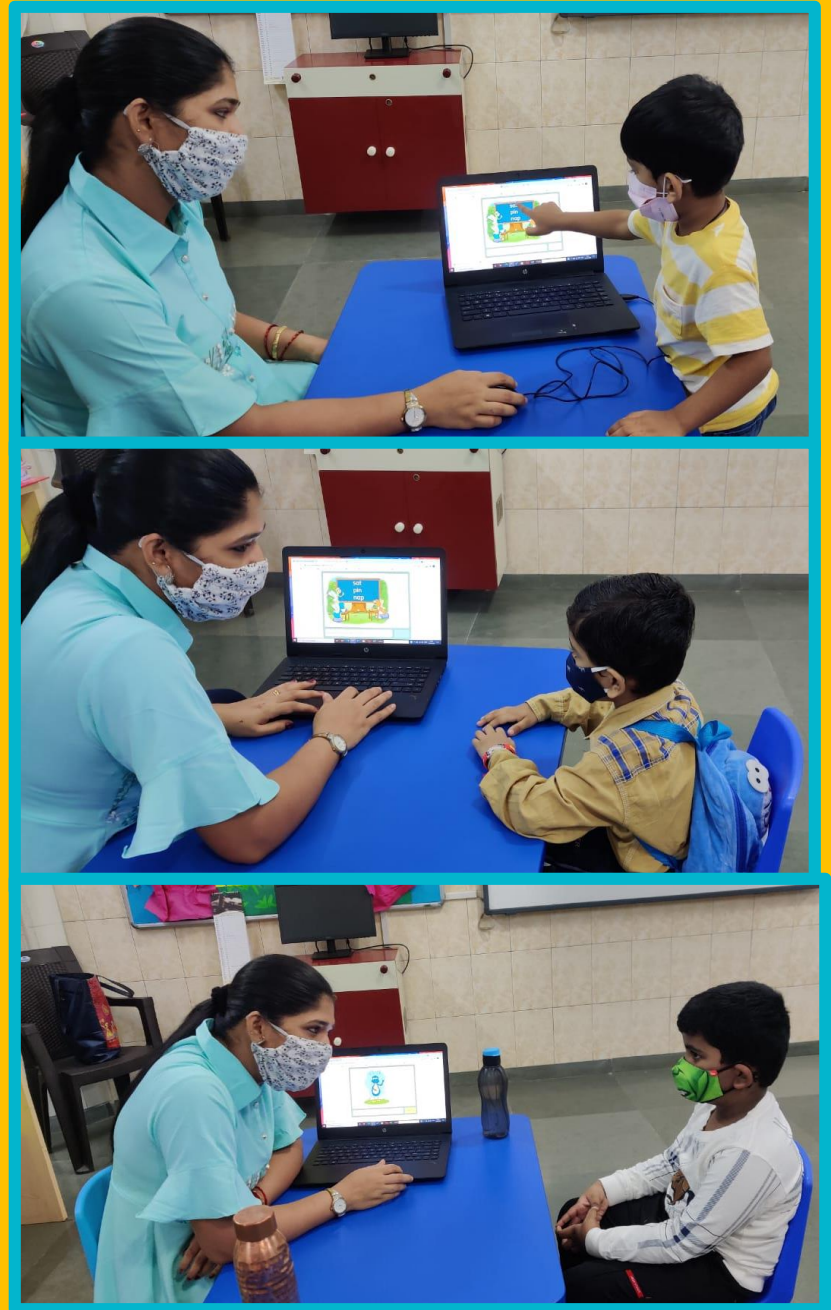
## In CEYP2



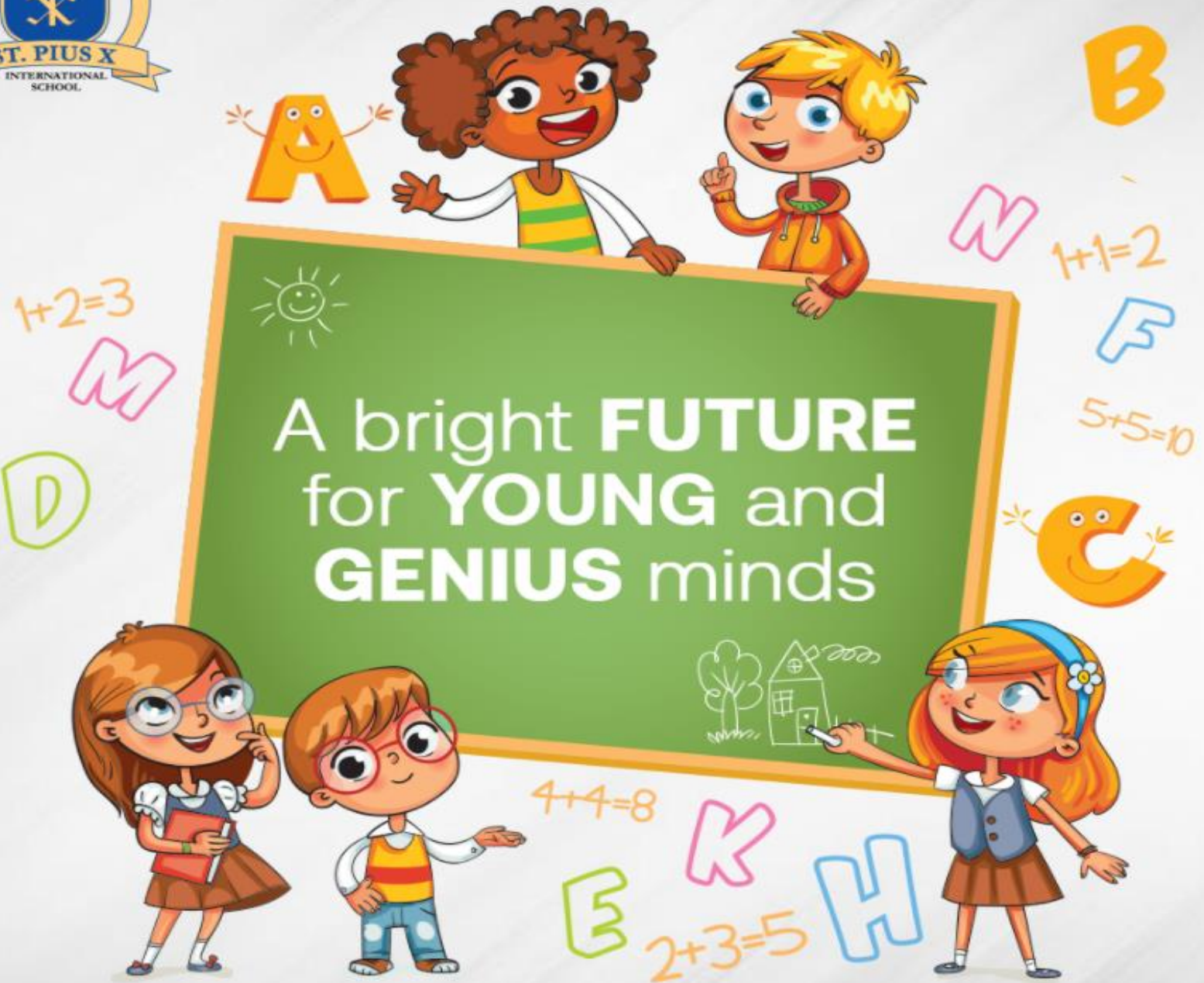
Accurately measuring a child's potential and progress is an important part of understanding and responding to their educational needs.

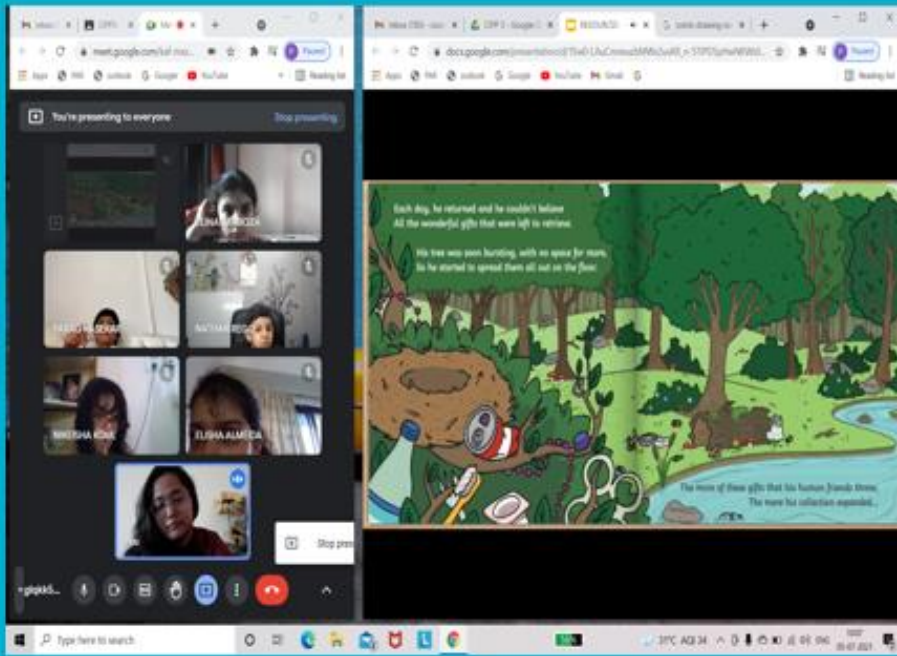
The Drama club conducted a story telling competition using puppets, for students of Cambridge Primary section.
